

Proceedings of the second Governing Body Meeting of Jharkhand Space Application Center held at Chief Secretary's Conference Room, Jharkhand Mantralaya, Dhurwa, Ranchi on 20th November, 2006 at 12.00 Noon onwards

1. Second Governing Body (GB) meeting of Jharkhand Space Application Center was held in the Conference Room of Chief Secretary, Government of Jharkhand, Mantralaya, Dhurwa, Ranchi on 20th November, 2006 from 12.00 noon onwards.
2. The list of Governing Body members, who had attended the meeting is annexed.
3. The GB confirmed the proceedings of First GB meeting and took note of the action taken report put up before it. While approving the first proceedings, the GB decided as under:
 - ❖ The Rules & Regulations including service conditions of JSAC employees should be revised and prepared within 3 months and put up for approval of Executive Committee and Governing Body in the next meeting.
 - ❖ The terms & conditions of service of JSAC employees may be considered and finalized keeping in view the terms and conditions in other State Space/Remote Sensing Application Centers.
 - ❖ Decided to shift the JSAC office to RRDA premises at the earliest till the construction of IT Building is done.
4. The GB strongly advised to conduct Workshops and Training Programmes for popularizing the utility of Space Applications for various development activities of State and further advised that different State Govt Departments must be involved in the day-to-day project activities of JSAC. The concerned user departments must be involved while implementing the projects.
5. The GB decided that the watersheds be prioritized using the GIS Database created by JSAC in consultation with the user departments.



6. The GB advised that a taskforce be constituted in consultation with Dept of Revenue and Land Reforms for collection of Village Cadastral/Land Records Maps from Guljarbag, Patna and further advised that a suitable arrangement be made for safe storage of the maps in Ranchi for future use.
7. The GB decided that officers of Revenue & Land Reforms and IT Departments to visit Lohardaga to monitor the status of the pilot project implementation of Land Records Information System and further the pilot project at Lohardaga must be completed as per schedule so that the statewide roadmap could be taken-up immediately thereafter.
8. The GB suggested that unemployed village youths could be involved to collect the village profile database by using the Questionnaire prepared by JSAC. Dy Commissioners and other District Officials could be involved in this regard.
9. The GB suggested to prepare agricultural/horticultural maps of Jharkhand State.
10. The GB suggested to fill-up the vacant posts early.
11. The GB advised that various projects undertaken by the JSAC must be completed soon as well as advised to present the details of the completion of the projects in the next GB meeting.
12. The GB approved the financial status and audited accounts of the JSAC for the years 2003-04, 2004-05 and 2005-06.
13. The GB renominated Dr. A.P.Subudhi, Director, JSAC to hold the office of Secretary, GB till the completion of his term of deputation.
